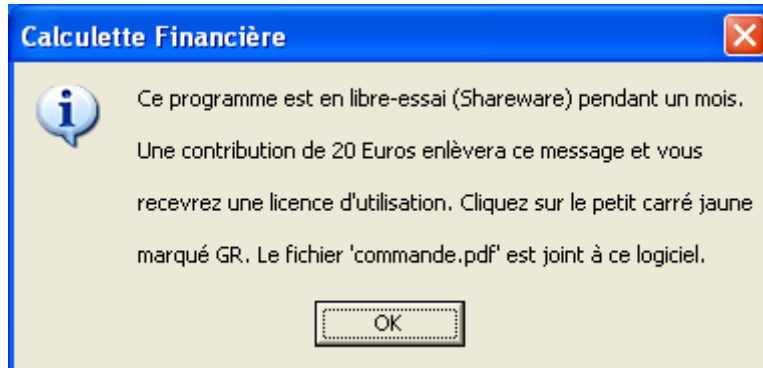


CALC_FIN HELP

This program is a trial version (Shareware). You can use it during one month.. Click the small yellow marked square GR to find my address if you want to pay by check (20 €). You may prefer to pay online (15 €) and obtain your license at once by clicking “Get online License”.



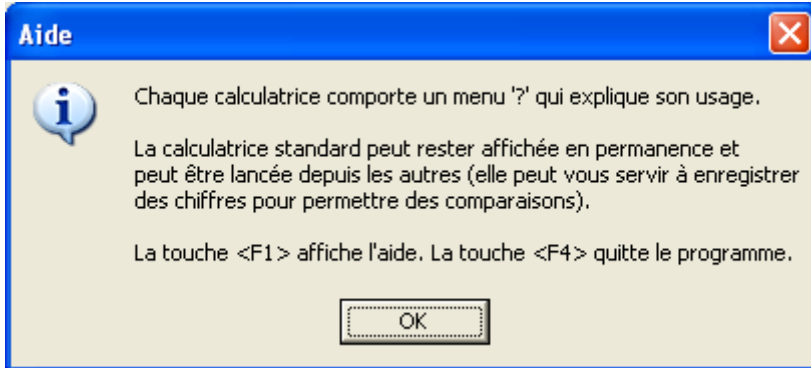
Do not forget to buy your license...

Message displayed when you click “AIDE”:

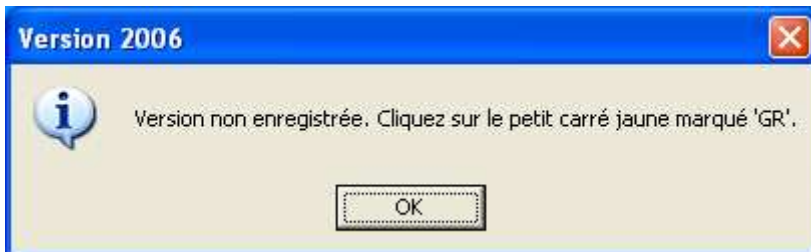


Each calculator includes a menu that explain how to use it.

Standard calculator may always remain displayed on your screen and can be run from any of them (may be used to register calculation results from one of the 3 calculators).

<F1> displays help. <F4> quit the program.

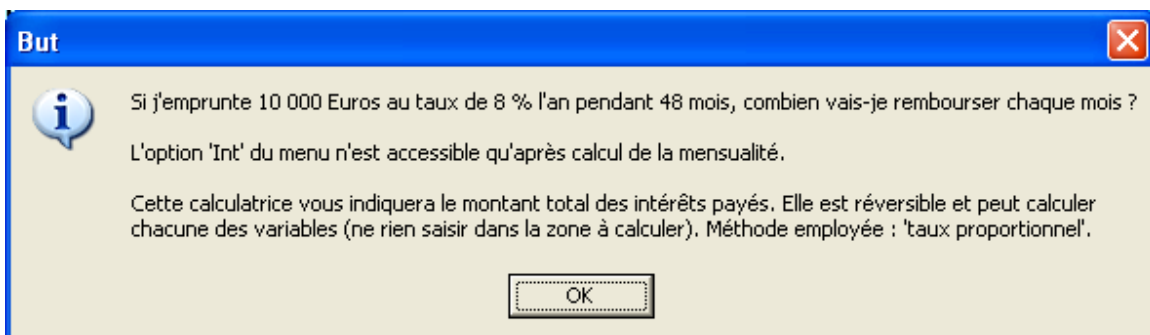
Message displayed when you click “#”:

This message appears when you click “?” on “ANNUITES CONSTANTES” calculator:

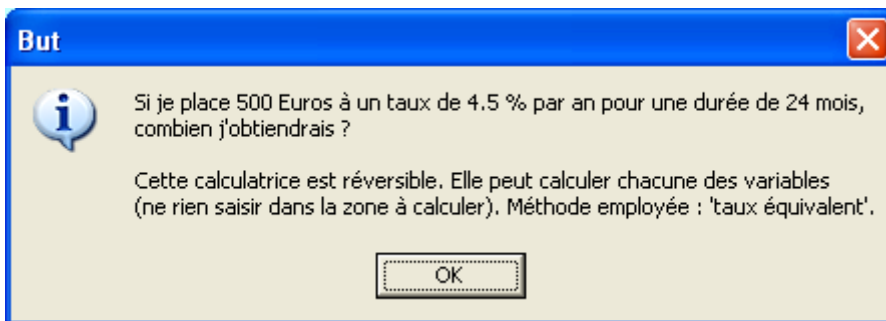


When I borrow 10 000 Euros with a interest rate equal to 8% per year, during 48 months (4 years) how much must I pay off each month?

The option “Int” of the menu may be run only after having run the main calculation.

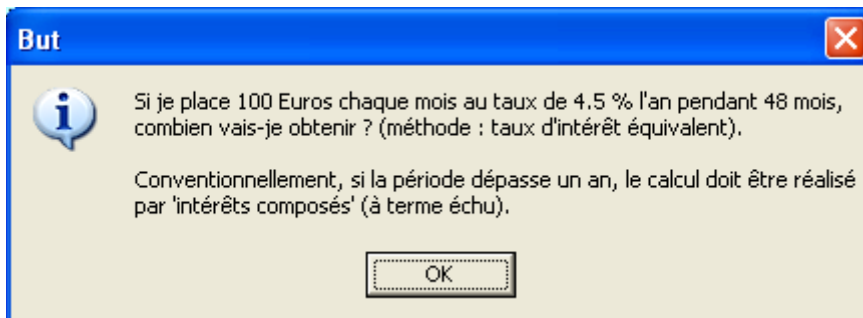
This calculator will display the total of interest paid. It is able to calculate any of each blank field but 3 of 4 must be entered.

This message appears when you click “?” on “INTERETS COMPOSES” calculator:



When I place 500 Euros at once time with an interest rate equal to 4,5% per year, during 24 months (2 years), how much may I obtain?

This message appears when you click “?” on “VALEUR ACQUISE” calculator:



If I place 100 Euros each month with the interest rate equal to 4,5% per year, during 48 months (4 years), how much may I obtain?
